



DRESS CODE

It has become apparent that some members are not adhering to our Dress Code policy. I now list below our requirements in this respect.

Shoes

Only Bowls shoes are permitted on the green. The wearing of normal footwear is NOT permitted on the green as they could damage our green. We must bear in mind the green is now 12 years old. Also if damaged any replacement would be approaching £50,000 which must have the consequence of an increased annual subscription.

Please do not travel to the Club in Bowls shoes either as damage could be caused by roughed up ground before arriving in addition to dirt etc.

Shirts/Trousers/Shorts

We now have our new Blue/gold kit which is becoming popular with members. Also the older white Club shirts with Club badge are still acceptable.

Any other shirts should be predominantly white.

National, County and other Club's bowling shirts are NOT acceptable and should not be worn.

Non kit trousers or shorts must be grey or black

Jackets/jumpers

Again these items should be predominantly white and jumpers of any other colour are NOT permitted.

We are very proud of our reputation in the Bowling world and the attention to our dress code ensures that we can be seen as a smart and well run Club which is fully supported by its members.
